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#### GUIDELINES FOR INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR) CELL

#### Objective of the IPR Cell

MGMCET identifies the immaterial IP resources like designs, developments, and other inventive and innovative items developed by faculty & research scholars, UG and PG students. The IPR cell, guides the individual or the group of faculty and researchers for filing patents or any related IPR application. The IPR Cell facilitates protection of the IP of the faculty, research scholars, UG and PG students employed in supported research and consultancy ventures. The guidelines are applicable to all the MGMCET personnel and Non-MGMCET personnel associated with MGMCET including industry expert, faculty members, research Scholars, PG student, UG students which covers all the classes of IP.

In compliance with National IPR policy released by Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP), Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Government of India, MGMCET proceeds with the following IP guidelines.



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#### Ownership:

Ownership of any IP arising from in-house research project rest with MGMCET in a whole.

The Ownership of a Sponsored or collaborative research project will follow the guidelines defined in the contract document.

#### Copyrights:

MGMCET shall be the owner of all copyright works (books, articles, scholarly publications, thesis, dissertation, term papers and other documents) including software and all connected teaching materials created for teaching purposes by employees of MGMCET.
